Bird Sculptures

Year 1 & Year 2 have been busy creating beautiful bird sculptures using a variety of artistic techniques. They began by scrunching paper, exploring how a flat 2D material can be transformed into a 3D form in different ways.

The children then used the papier-mâché technique to make their birds strong and sturdy before painting and decorating them. To add detail and texture, they practised coiling, curling and cutting paper to create colourful wings and tails.

The finished sculptures showcase the children's creativity, perseverance and developing sculpting skills, and they are incredibly proud of their work.
