Mathematician:

As well as completing your weekly maths homework, continue to build your knowledge of money and time with these games:



Scientist:

Research the difference between vertebrate and invertebrate animals and create a poster with your favourites!

Reader:

This term we are reading *'How to Train your Dragon'*. Taking inspiration from the text, design and present your own dragon species. Consider their diet, size, special abilities, their habitat.

Designer:

This term we will investigate and create neon signs. Create your own sign using a simple circuit or a torch.

Writer:

Using *How to train your Dragon* by Cressida Cowell as inspiration, write your own dragon poem.

Spanish:

We are learning about Spanish festivals, you could do some research and create a poster all about your favourite festival.

Discover:

Who was Pythagoras? How is he linked to Maths? What is Pythagoras' theory? Present your findings—use diagrams to explain what you have learnt.
